Class Drop/Add

As everyone settles into their classes and student levels get adjusted, don't forget to fill out a drop/add form at the front desk if you make changes to your schedule. Even if you've discussed the change with your instructors, please make sure and inform the front desk of any changes.

Reminder for Music Students

Music lessons must be canceled 24 hours in advance in order to receive credit for the lesson and allow scheduling adjustments by the teacher. In the case of sudden illness, **the instructor must be contacted directly no later than noon on the day of the lesson (earlier if possible)**. If an instructor is contacted less than three hours before a scheduled lesson, it will be up to the instructor whether to apply a credit.

Also, please do not drop-off students more than 15 minutes before their lesson and pick them up promptly when their lesson is completed.
