The following roles have been, pre-cast:

Auditions for the following roles will be October 28th at noon:

- Mother Gothel, she steals Rapunzel as a baby. This is a high demand role, requiring strong dancing and acting skills. Age middle school and older.
- Kale/Coral, Rapunzel's spunky and mischievous younger Brother/Sister. This is a high demand role requiring strong dancing and acting skills. Age 5<sup>th</sup> grade and older.
- 3 Village Kids, the story of Rapunzel will be told to them at the beginning of the show and they will
  participate in the LPAC opening number. This is a low demand role for younger/smaller dancers, acting
  and dancing skills required.
- Narrator, will appear at various points in the story and will also be used for voice overs to push the story along. This is an acting-only medium demand role.
- Schnitzel, Rapunzel's Pet Duck. This is a high demand role for a small/younger dancer. This role requires a
  good memory for choreography and non-speaking acting skills. Must have patience for long rehearsal
  days.
- Twin Rogues, troublemakers that the brother/sister runs into in the forest. This is a low demand role requiring dancing and acting. Any age.
- Professor, Brother/Sister's teacher tasked with tracking him/her down. This is a medium demand role requiring dance and acting skills. Age 5<sup>th</sup> grade and up.
- 2 Teacher's Pets, assistants to the professor. Low demand role for younger dancers, requires dance and maybe acting.
- Cupid Ruffian, their dream is to be a wedding planner. This is a medium to high demand role that requires dancing and acting. Any age.
- Hook Ruffian, their dream is to be piano or guitar player for Taylor Swift. This is a medium to high demand role that requires dancing and acting. Middle school and older.
- Taylor Swift lookalike. Low demand role. Requires dancing, acting, and singing. Age 5th grade and up.

You must be enrolled at LaBelle Performing Arts to audition and have a completed audition permission form signed by a parent or guardian. Students selected for a featured role will be expected to attend all required rehearsals, these rehearsals may take place during the week, and Friday and Saturday. A one-time rehearsal fee of \$75 will be due in February. Featured character costumes are the responsibility of the student and may be more than the cost of recital costumes. Rehearsals will begin after the Christmas break.
